

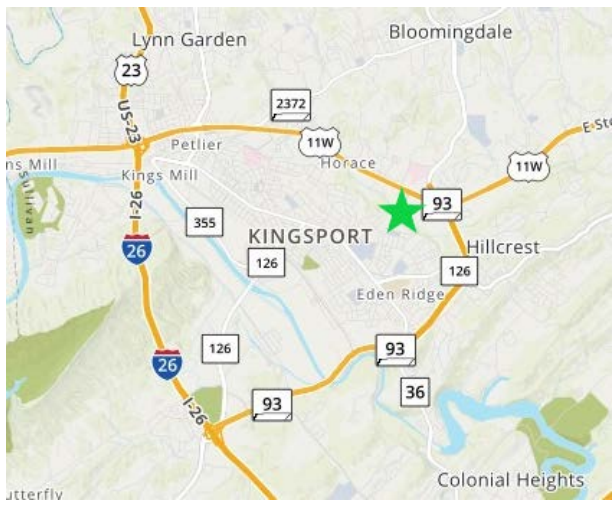
Why should someone contact Creekside Behavioral Health?

You will receive a free and confidential level-of-care assessment conducted by a master's level professional or a psychiatric nurse. The assessment specialist will seek personal insight into your past and current symptoms in a compassionate manner to determine what level of care you need. We ensure that everyone will be treated with dignity and professional courtesy. Treatment options will be explored with you in accordance to your specific needs.

WHO PAYS FOR TREATMENT?

Assessment and referral services are always FREE. A financial counselor is available to discuss each individual's personal financial options and will work with clients without insurance coverage on a private-pay basis. Creekside accepts Medicaid, Medicare, and most commercial insurance plans.

At Creekside we believe recovery is a process. Utilizing the Hazeldon/Betty Ford COR-12 (Comprehensive Opioid Response with the 12 Steps), our chemical dependency programs effectively combine the best of medical and social treatment models to achieve optimal results. Our evidenced based treatment programs utilize behavior modification and offer the following services:

- Withdrawal Management (Medically Monitored Detoxification)
- Psychiatry
- Medication Management
- Medication Assisted Treatment

OUTPATIENT DRUG AND ALCOHOL SERVICES

CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (CD-IOP)

This program offers more frequent intensity of care than traditional outpatient therapy. Patients spend three hours a day, for up to five days a week receiving comprehensive treatment at Creekside Behavioral Health. Patients in our outpatient CD-IOP program will benefit from working with the same clinical staff they were matched with while receiving care in our inpatient program. We believe this continuity of care model will improve patient outcomes and community and family reintegration.

The CD-IOP program applies multiple evidence-based approaches; Living in Balance, Illness Management and Recovery, and Seeking Safety for management of co-occurring illness.
